

About this Statement

This statement relates to the business and web site operations of Nextel Pty Ltd (Nextel) and its subsidiaries, owners and associated businesses.

We respect your privacy, both personal and business, it is important to us. Everyone who have relation to Nextel your information is safe with us.

The information about how we collect, use, disclose and manage the information about our clients is mentioned in this Privacy statement.

For the identification about you or the company you represent our website and the related documents are there where you can provide the information.

While using your information we take the rational steps to act in accordance with this privacy statement.

On accessing other websites that user is able to access through our website we are not responsible for any such information practice.

When you apply or subscribe to any of Nextel services or purchase any of Nextel products, you give us consent to the collection and use of your information in agreement with the supply of those services or products and this Privacy Statement and our Terms and Conditions of Use.

What Information Do We Collect?

The information collected from you depends on the services or products you are ordering or requesting and that we provide to you.

We may collect information like personal details like name, business details like business name, business number also email address, postal address and phone number. In certain services we may also collect other demographic information in order to provide better services.

For purchasing our services or products, we will require to collect your credit card information and/or bank account details.

Credit Checking and Reporting

We require your information before accepting your application, relevant to our assessment of your credit rating.

According to the Privacy Act we are allowed to provide a credit reporting agency certain personal information about you. The information we disclose to a credit reporting agency includes permitted information:

- That will allow you to be recognized,
- That you have applied for credit and the amount,
- That we are a current credit supplier to you,
- About credit account repayments that are overdue,
- About credit account repayments for which debt collection action has started,
- That in our opinion you have committed a serious credit infringement (i.e. we believe you have acted fraudulently or shown an intention not to comply with your credit obligations),
- About Direct Debits authorised by you drawn on your account and cheques drawn by you for \$100 or more that have been dishonoured.

We will obtain from a credit reporting agency a credit report containing information about your personal and business creditworthiness for the purposes of assessing your application and assisting in collecting overdue payments, and to our obtaining information about your commercial activities or commercial credit worthiness from any business that provides information about the commercial credit worthiness of persons, your accountant or any other supplier to you.

We will obtain from any credit provider named in your Application or in a credit report about you issued by a credit reporting agency, information about your credit arrangements for the purposes of assessing your Application, notifying a default by you, allowing another credit provider to ascertain the status of your arrangements with us where you are in default with one or more other credit providers and generally assessing your credit worthiness.

The information exchanged can include any information about your business, personal and/or commercial credit worthiness, credit standing, credit history or credit capacity which the Privacy Act allows credit providers to give to or receive from each other.

Other Information

Other information may also be recorded. Whenever you access a web page from our web server, we record the time, date and Internet Protocol (IP) address of the request, along with information on the browser software being used. We use this information to gain knowledge about the use of our web site(s) and to improve our marketing methods and technical performance. This information is not used to specifically identify you.

Nextel web sites may also use cookies—pieces of information that a web site can transfer to an individual's computer. Cookies can make the Nextel web site(s) easier to use by storing information about your preferences relating to your use of our web site(s). Most major web sites use cookies. Your Internet browser software is usually pre-set to accept cookies. However, if you'd prefer not to receive them, you can change your browser settings to refuse them or to warn you when cookies are being used. If you elect to refuse cookies, the functionality of certain Nextel web site(s) may no longer be available to you.

How We Use Your Information

We may use your contact details to occasionally send you information about Nextel and its products and services, including material such as information on new products and services we may offer. We have an anti-spam policy. Your credit card number and/or bank account details will be used only to charge you for the services for which you have authorised, applied or subscribed and/or the products you have purchased.

We will treat the information we collect from you as strictly confidential. Other than as set out herein, we will not reveal, disclose, sell, distribute, rent, licence, share or pass on to any third parties, other than those who are contracted or supply services to Nextel, any personal information that you may have provided to us unless we have your express consent to do so.

Exceptions

Nextel reserves the right at all times to disclose any information as Nextel deems necessary

- to satisfy any applicable law, regulation, legal process or governmental request, or
- where there are reasonable grounds to believe that disclosure is necessary to prevent a threat to life or health.

Nextel will not share your individual personal information with advertisers but may disclose to them aggregated demographic information in relation to Nextel users that does not identify you or your individual business.

Security

Nextel strives to protect your information and accordingly, it is kept in a secure environment accessed only by authorised Nextel staff and service providers.

However, the open nature of the Internet means no data transmission can be guaranteed 100% secure.

Accordingly, we cannot guarantee the security of any information you transmit to us or receive from our online products or services. Therefore, these activities are conducted at your own risk. Once Nextel receives your information, we will use our best efforts to ensure its security.
